A very sincere 'Thank you' to all who have shown full respect for the staggered start and finish times set in place in order to protect our children and staff and keep the class bubbles safe.

With this in mind, we can now reduce the time between each staggered start as follows:

P7 - Mrs Kinsella/Miss Mc Veigh (Bottom Gate via bottom of front yard)

9:30am P3 - Mrs Nugent (Bottom Gate via bottom of front yard)

P4 - Mr Hanna (Top Gate via bottom of front yard.)

This allows for all pupils to be in school for 9:30am.

Staggered home times remain as before.

Few additional reminders:-

- All children need to bring a coat to school every day. Make sure their name and class is on their coat.
- Thank you to all who have returned reading books and texts books can I please appeal to anyone who still has resources from lock down to return them on or before this Friday 11th September to allow for them to be quarantined for 72 hours in a store room for use next week again.
- Please apply for free school meals on EA website as soon as possible if you think your child may be entitled to them.
- Do not engage staff at the gates at any time; phone into the school and the teacher will return your call when they are free to do so and as soon as they can.
