Allergy Aware School.

Please remember that St Patrick's PS has children with nut allergies.

This can be life-threatening for the children with the nut allergy if they should consume anything containing nuts by accident.

Parking and leaving.

Once again, when parking to drop off or pick up pupils check you leave the gates and drive ways of residents across from the school free and do not park and block them in or out of their homes.

Recently, an increasing number of parents are doing 'U-Turns' from the school gates directly across to Annabann on the opposite side of the road.

I am asking everyone not to do this as children and parents are walking across and it is causing unnecessary traffic jams in an already heavily congested road. PLEASE drive down to the intersection past the school and turn there safely.

Morning Club.

Morning Club was put into place to support those parents who need to leave their child/ren to school before we start officially each day at 9:05am. It is essential in all schools that all children on the premises at any time are fully supervised for Health and Safety and Child Protection reasons. It is a legal requirement.

No one is paid to supervise Morning Club which begins at 8:00am.

Contribution of £1 a day (£5 per week) go towards resources, prizes for competitions and raffles held at school such as Christmas and Easter raffles, Internet Safety and Anti-Bullying Poster Competitions, reducing travel costs for buses for class trips – the list is endless.

All children coming onto the school premises before 9:05am

must go to the Morning Club as this is where the supervision is to keep them safe.

This is the provision we have put in place to help support all parents who need to leave their child/ren off early to get to work. It includes all and excludes none. We ask payment to be made on the first day of every week for that week and that children are registered for the club so numbers can be monitored and adequate supervision is available at all times.
