Morning Club/2-3pm Club for 2022 - 2023

Morning Club starts at 8:00am - 9:10am.

Children can arrive after 8:00am but they must still be registered for Morning Club as this is the only supervision available before class.

All children enter by the back door into the hall for the club.

2 - 3pm Club (P2 & P3)

Cost £5 per week per child signed up to each club irrespective of how many days they do or do not attend.

Daily Register will be kept of all attendees and weekly payments recorded - money paid on first day of each week for that week.

The school does not receive Extended school's funding. Consequently, no one is paid to cover these clubs. All money raised goes to school funds.

Healthy Kidz Programmes.

P2 - P7 pupils are more than half way through their Healthy Kidz sessions and well done to all participants for their energy, commitment and attendance at all sessions to date!

We hope to send out letters of interest for Term 2 and see if there is demand for other programmes.

Funding from DE/EA for 'Healthy, Happy Minds' initiative.

DE/EA have made available a sum of money to support children and their Mental Health in the coming weeks.

It is planned for Healthy Kidz to take sessions initially in P1 -P4 classes for 30 - 40minutes one day a week with a focus on Emotional wellbeing, particularly resilience coupled with some physical activity.

While it will not, unfortunately, be possible to support each child individually, feel all children will benefit from the sessions within class groups.

We hope the funding will be extended further in Term 2 that will allow us to include KS2 classes also.

Daily Mile

Every class in the school are involved in doing the Daily Mile with their teachers and Teaching Assistants each day this term. Some jog while others walk at a pace but all are involved and enjoying the experience. This is all part of the mental health and welfare programme this year for our pupils alongside other initiatives above.
