Dear Parent/Guardian,

RE: External and internal work planned for St Patrick's PS:

Monday 5th December will see the start of outdoor work and some internal work in relation to upgrading Fire Safety upstairs by way of putting in an external fire escape stairway from the first floor to ground level and creating a safe play area for the children in the Learning Support Class.

Contractors will require two work areas

- the first for the play area and the second where the steel stair will be. This will affect how we run things for the week as we will not be able to use the hard playground at the front of the school i.e. between the school and the road.

IN THE MORNINGS:

- -We will have restricted access to the main door and all classes and children will enter via the top pedestrian gate in the mornings and follow the footpath around to the backyard of the school.
- P1 P3 Staff will line children up in the space between the main double gates and the staff cars parked on site in the mornings and walk their class in.
- P4 P7 pupils will go to class as normal in the mornings.

AT HOME TIMES:

- P1 P3 staff will bring their classes to line up in the space between the main double gates and the staff cars on site. ALL parents/child minders collecting children MUST come to the top pedestrian gate and teachers will send children to you. Please DO NOT enter the school grounds.
- P4 P7 staff will bring their classes to line up in the space between the double main gates and staff cars on site. Once again, please go to the top pedestrian gate and children will be sent to you. DO NOT ENTER THE SCHOOL GROUNDS.

Late arrivals, early finishers, collecting a child who is sick Please follow all current arrangements RING IN FROM THE CAR to the office for staff member to go to the gate and collect your child. DO NOT ENTER THE SCHOOL GROUNDS if your child is arriving late to school.

Likewise, when collecting a child early, ring into the school and your child will be brought to you.

It is essential for health and safety reasons that everyone follows the directions above.

It is hoped that the work will be finished within 1 - 2 weeks but we will keep you informed.

Thank you all for your support and help during this time.

We will walk all pupils through the change to morning and home time routines this week and ensure they are all familiar with changes.

We will also close the infant pedestrian gate and the main gates from Wednesday 30th November and begin the temporary organisation for school arrivals and home times and collections.

This allows us time to tweak any further changes necessary to ensure the safety of all children and adults on site.

Many thanks, once again, for your help and cooperation in ensuring everyone stays safe while the work takes place.
