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#### Morning Club for 2023 - 2024

Club will be £5 per weekly contribution per child.

Once again it will open at 8:00am and all pupils on school premises before 9:00 MUST attend morning club.

Registration form will be available from Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June and places will be limited to 30 pupils.

Primary 1 pupils can not be registered as they need time to settle into the school and the longer day and new routines first.

All attending the club MUST be registered and full contributions for the days the school is on each week must be paid by all who are registered. Non-payment will result in places being reallocated to those on a waiting list.

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#### 2 - 3 Club - Starting 4th September 2023.

Arrangements as above for the Morning Club however, 2 - 3 Club is for P2 and P3 pupils ONLY and is to allow a single pick-up for families.

All attending the club MUST be registered and full contributions for the days the school is on each week must be paid by all who are registered. Non-payment will result in places being reallocated to those on a waiting list.

#### Classes and Structure for 2023/24.

Cuts within Education and the dramatic rise in cost of living and running costs have been very well documented in Media circles for several months now. We, like many other schools, must make decisions regarding how we can begin to manage the loss of funding with the rise in running costs. For this reason alone, it is necessary to reduce staffing in the main school and restructure classes from September 2023 as follows:-

P2: - Mrs Bradley & Anon (job share)

P3: - Mrs Nugent

P4/5a: - Mrs Kinsella

P4/5b: - Mrs Kenwell

P6: - Miss McVeigh

P7: - Mr Hanna

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SP-EYF 'Snowdrop Class': - Ms McGilly

SP-EYF 'Daffodil Class': - Miss Hughes

The division of P5 is solely sorted by age in years and complete months and children with SEN were exempt from this process. First Communion and P4 Religion will be covered by Mrs Kinsella and Mrs Kenwell will take P5 Religion. Both P4/5 classes will work in tandem covering same topics and themes and having equal time for any outside providers such as Relax Kids or coaching sessions and trips during the year. Both classes will mix freely on the yard at break and lunch times.

Class Teachers will be attached to each pupil's report and sent out before the end of June for P4/5 classes.

## **Proof of Benefit Letters**

Parents/guardians who are currently in receipt of the below benefits, will need to upload a Proof of Benefit Letter, along with their application. Applicants can request this by visiting this website. We ask that you remind your parent community of this requirement, as an application cannot be processed until we receive all supporting documentation for the applicant.

- \* Income Support;
- \* Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance;
- \* Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit.
